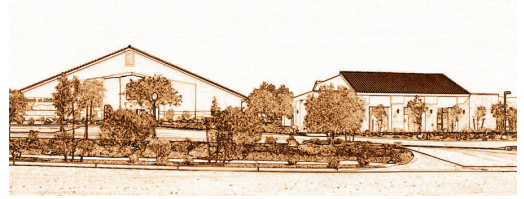

## SAFE IN THE ARMS OF JESUS

From the first page to the last, the Bible speaks of security. How many times has God said that he would be with us? "I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20) is not just words on a page. Even of old God's people were not to go to the Egyptians or any other nation for protection from invaders. They were to have reliance on God. God was their refuge, their sustainer, their provider. (2 Samuel 22:3; Psalm 9:9; 46:1)

We are taught in many ways that God will take care of us. Consider the lilies of the field how they grow, they toil not neither do they spin, but yet I say that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if it be the case that God so clothe the grass of the field, will he not also clothe us? (Matthew 6:28)

The Israelite was confident that his home would be secure from marauders when he went to Jerusalem for to worship. (Exodus 23:20; 34:20)

The many teachings on faith, trust, assurance, and the peace that passeth all understanding are given to fortify our security. We sing songs that speak of being "safe and secure from all alarm," having "blessed assurance," "leaning on Jesus," and hiding our souls in "the cleft of the rock," all for the purpose of teaching and admonishing one another on how secure we are with God on our side. (Colossians 3:16)

The psalmist understood that there was nowhere he could go where he was not under the almighty hand of God. If he went to the uttermost parts of the sea - God was there. Even if he went to the grave - behold God is there. (Psalm 139:8)
