

LIBRARY FOR LIBERIA

Ken Bolden, a life long friend of **Paul Hestand**, went to assist the faculty and board at Liberia Bible College (founded 1986) in 2016. The school had been functional and recognized by the Liberia Commission for Higher Education as certified to award AA degrees in Bible. Between 1986 and 1997 the school had trained over 100 men. The country was involved in a brutal civil war between 1987 and 2003. There are Nigerian UN Peace keepers still around "just in case". During those years the property was ruined and the Christian library was burned. Ken is trying to gather 4,000 religious books to reestablish the library. Paul Hestand is collecting for the cause. If you have religious books you would like to donate, please bring to the kitchen. If you would rather contribute money, you can give it to Paul. The money is needed for books, shipping costs, bookshelves, renovating the library (tile flooring, paint, LED lighting, computer setups - \$2,000) and a dehumidifier to protect the books (average humidity 85-90% - \$350). Books and funds will be shipped to Sheridan church of Christ in Sheridan, AR
