If your child is going to camp tomorrow, please check with **Shawn Driscoll** today, to ensure that there are not any outstanding items.

If you have a re-filleable, plastic, drink container, please send one along with your child, as there will be some hikes.

Please be sure to have your child to the church building Monday morning, **no later than 7:00am**. If you have items to turn into Shawn (ie: Medicine, Spending money, forms, etc.) you need to arrive at least 15 minutes earlier. Make sure that your child has a sack lunch (including a drink), as we will not be stopping anywhere on the way to purchase food or drinks.

If your child will not be riding the bus to or from camp, you must notify Shawn Driscoll prior to tomorrow. If you are planning on playing paint ball, the cost is now \$20.00 a round, so you need to bring another five dollars if you already paid, and twenty if you haven't paid yet.
