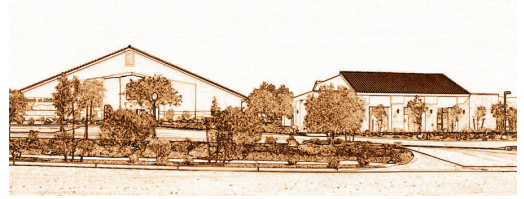

. . . In Exodus, "the Lord said, 'I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering.'" (4:7). To paraphrase Dr. Rix, God meets us at our worst possible suffering. We are not privy to why evil exists in the world at all, and why suffering inevitably worms its way into the lives of every human on earth, but is it not comforting to have a God who walks through the storm with us? Great adversity invites God closer to us, through a deepening of our faith in his transcendence. . . .
