He did not do his own will: (John 4:34; 6:38; Luke 22:42). If we would be like Christ, then we must also lift our eyes heavenward not

directing our own steps. Until we learn to be dependent upon God, He will not accept us.

Christ was obedient: (Heb. 5:8-9). His obedience was from the heart. Just because our life happens to conform to the will of God is not proof that we are obedient. When we deliberately and lovingly do his will, we are obedient.

Christ had bowels of mercy: Colossians 3:12 speaks of having bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, and longsuffering. All these attributes bear relationship to one another. One of the greatest needs of Christians in our day is being merciful. Being embittered, overly harsh, jumping to conclusions, will bring like judgment upon our own selves. For with what judgment we judge, it is by that judgment we will be judged (Matthew 7:2).

Christ was forgiving: What does it mean to be like Christ when it comes to forgiveness? There is a twofold punch to this statement: we are to forgive those who once despised us and we are not to forgive those who do not want forgiveness. We cannot dismiss sin when Christ does not dismiss it.

The song speaks of *"helping the helpless, Cheering the fainting, seeking the wand'ring sinner to find."* If we are to be like Jesus, we must keep our hands busy with his work. The song speaks of benevolence, edification, and evangelism.
